## Upgrading Firmware for TP-Link Archer C20 v4.x

 Check that you are in fact upgrading the C20 v4 – the model should be "Archer C20" and the number should say "v4"



- 2. Download the latest firmware file for the router @ <u>HERE</u>
- 3. Connect to the router either via a LAN cable connecting your Laptop or PC to the router directly or by connecting a device, such as a phone or tablet, to the wireless network.
- 4. Log in the router's management interface by browsing to here. <u>http://192.168.0.1/</u> the username and password should be "admin" and "admin" click login once you have entered the credentials.
- 5. Go to System Tools > Firmware Upgrade.
- 6. Click **Choose File** to locate the downloaded firmware file most likely from your downloads folder, and click **Upgrade**.
